To Log in to the options system...

When you access the website you will be asked to log in. To do this you need sign in using the same method as you do for your Homework.

Making your choices:

Option Choices

Please indicate the <u>THREE COURSES</u> you would like follow as a level three programme of study below. In addition to your choices select <u>ONE RESERVE</u> option using the 'reserve' button.

You can re-order the subjects on the righthand side in order of preference; this is important as it **WILL** be taken into account when organising the final option blocks.

Fourth Option:

We are aware that some students may wish to study a **FOURTH** subject across the two years, however this will need to be agreed through the interview process. If this is something you possibly want to do then please indicate the subject you wish to study as your **reserve** choice and add a **note** in the **comments** section to explain this.

NOTE:

The BTEC National Diploma in Business course and the BTEC National Diploma in Health and Social Care course each count as the equivalent of <u>two A levels</u>; therefore, if you choose one of them as part of your academic programme, you need only choose <u>one</u> other subject to go with it.

If you choose to study the BTEC National Diploma in Business you **CANNOT** also study the BTEC Extended Certificate in Business.
