<p>Does your partner...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accept you exactly how you are? Compromise? Respect you, your thoughts, opinions and choices? Compliment you? Treat you as an equal in all things? Allow you to say no? Apologise? Make you feel safe emotionally, sexually, physically and spiritually? Support you even if they disagree? Encourage you to see your friends and family? Make you laugh? 	<p><i>"The process by which a person comes to support terrorism or forms of extremism that supports terrorism."</i></p> <p>This is not just Islamic extremism it can also include fascism, racism, being anti-Jewish or agreeing with Nazism, for example.</p> <p>Are you worried about a friend or classmate who might show a hatred for people from other faiths, ethnicities people groups, or counties? Worried about what they might do? Let us know</p> <p>Talk to a member of staff you trust You can also get help and advice from www.ltai.info</p>	<p>Extreme Right-Wing Symbols, numbers and acronyms:</p> <p>At our School, we believe that everyone has the right to enjoy a sense of belonging, where learning and working is designed with all of us in mind.</p>  <p>If you see, anyone displaying these symbols in the School then report it immediately. Tell any member of staff.</p>
<p>These are examples of a healthy relationship.</p> <p>Abuse in relationships, sometimes called Domestic Abuse, can happen to anyone, male or female. If your relationship leaves you feeling scared, hurt, intimidated or controlled, it is possible you are in an abusive relationship.</p>	<p>FGM (Female Genital Mutilation)</p> <p>We are here to help!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Female Genital Mutilation is all procedures involving partial or total removal of the external female genitalia or other deliberate injury to the female genital organs for non-medical reasons. <p>This is illegal in the UK as it always causes both physical and emotional pain for the victim. No religion or holy text teaches the practice of FGM. If you or someone you know has had this done to them or is at risk of having this done, report it and we can help.</p> <p>Talk to a member of staff you trust. You can also get help and advice by searching FGM NHS online.</p>	<p>CSE (Child Sexual Exploitation)</p> <p>We are here to help!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Are you being forced, threatened, manipulated, coerced or blackmailed into doing things of a sexual nature that you do not want to do? By someone you know or online? Do you feel unable to say no? <p><i>CSE can involve taking and sending naked or sexualised pictures or videos when you do not want to, being forced to do things of a sexual nature to someone or letting them do something to you. It is never the victim's fault; this affects both males and females.</i></p>
