GCE and GCSE exams start on Wednesday 8th May and run until Friday 28th June. All exam students have been emailed and given paper copies of their timetables and seating arrangements. It is vital that students arrive in plenty of time for their exams and have all the correct equipment with them. If a student is too unwell on an exam day to attend, the school must be phoned no later than 8:30am with details of the illness and a Self-Certification for candidates who have missed an exam JCQ/ME form 14 must be completed. Please contact reception on 01379 642424 where a form can be emailed to you, or you can collect from reception.

Please ensure students have the following items for their exams:

- Two black pens
- Two pencils
- An eraser
- A sharpener or lead if using a mechanical pencil
- A ruler
- A clear see-through pencil case
- A clear see-through bottle of water
- Maths equipment such as protractor, compass, and calculator for maths exams
