Purpose:	The 16-19 Tuition Fund is additional one year funding to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus. It is ring fenced to provide small group tuition for students aged 16-19.				

STATEMENT - PLANNED USE OF FUNDING

Whilst the use of Centre Assessed Grades to award GCSEs in summer 2020 has allowed most students to progress to the next stage in their education, Diss High School Sixth Form has eleven students for whom this is not the case. This funding will be used to provide these students with support between their return to school in September 2020 and the November 2020 series of GCSE examinations. The support, primarily provided for English GCSE, but which also covers entries for Maths and Physics, includes:

- Weekly revision sessions with teachers;
- Creation of Google & Seneca Learning classrooms with revision resources;
- Access to learning resources;
- Provision of revision guides;
- Provision and marking of exam practice tasks; and
- Pre-exam sessions on the day of the exam.
